Especialista em Ortopedia desde 1991. Assistente convidado da cadeira de ortopedia, na Faculdade de Ciências Médicas de Lisboa de 1991 a 1998. Grau de Consultor de Ortopedia desde 1999.

Foi Assistente Hospitalar no Departamento de Oncologia Cirúrgica do IPO de Lisboa de 1996 a 1998, coordenou a Unidade de Artroscopia do joelho do HOSA e foi nomeado Diretor, de Serviço e Clínico, do HOSA. Esteve ligado ao SL Benfica de 1991 a 2018, tendo sido coordenador da Orto-Traumatologia do Clube nos últimos doze anos. Integrou três Direções da Sociedade Portuguesa de Artroscopia e Traumatologia Desportiva.

Atualmente desempenha funções de Diretor do Hospital Ortopédico de Sant'Ana da Santa Casa da Misericórdia de Lisboa.

António Martins graduated in Medicine in 1980 from the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Lisbon. He is a Specialist in Orthopaedic Surgery and Traumatology since 1991. He was appointed Head of Orthopaedic Surgery Department at HOSA (Hospital ortopédico de Santana), and also nominated Clinical Director at HOSA. Worked with the Medical Department of SL Benfica (one of Lisbon's Football clubs) between 1991 and 2018, serving as Head of Orthopaedics and Traumatology during the latter twelve. Served as Board Member of the Portuguese Society of Arthroscopy and Sports Traumatology in three terms.
